A RESOLUTION ON ELECTED OFFICIALS' WAGES

WHEREAS, the City has established wages for elected officials for their service and time rendered on behalf of the community.

WHEREAS, the City regularly surveys other local government positions throughout the State of Utah to identify prevailing wages for comparable positions for local government elected officials for comparable local government entities.

WHEREAS, the Oakley City Council has not adjusted wages for elected officials for a significant period of time and recognizes that individuals serving the City in an elected capacity commit time and resources to the welfare of the community.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that elected officials' wages shall be identified, reviewed, and adjusted annually in accordance with the same procedures applied to all other City employees in the budget process. The public hearing for elected officials' wages shall be held as part of the hearings for the annual budget.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the annual wage of the Mayor be adjusted from \$4200 to \$6400 annually and City Council wage be adjusted from \$2,400 to \$3,600 annually.
