- A. The applicants have met all the required criteria and plat amendments from preliminary plat review.
- B. Final plat includes the following plat notes:
  - I. This parcel, OTBV-254-A is zoned Agricultural 5 and as such, the development density of this parcel has been filled. The parcel has 3 development rights. Two of the development rights were used by Lot 2 and Lot 3, and the third development right was transferred to parcel OTBV-254 and becomes Lot 1. The transfer of development right is included in "First Amendment to Maintenance & Use Agreement" recorded with Summit County as Entry No. 01146820.
  - II. All lots created by this subdivision must abide by the terms and conditions of "First Amendment to Maintenance & Use Agreement "recorded with Summit County, Utah as Entry No. 01146820.
  - III. All lots created by this subdivision must adhere to existing public utility easements for the Oakley City water line design.
- IV. All future ponds or irrigation needs for all lots will be done with irrigation or well water and not Oakley City culinary water.
- C. Still outstanding are the inspection of the water line by Oakley City Public Works Director and signing of the Water Line Extension Agreement.
